The Board met on July 7 at 6:30 pm. Pastor Jon opened the meeting with a devotional. After the group prayer the board worked on the following...

- Normal financial and church business. With your faithful giving we have slightly exceeded the budgeted 6-month goal for income. Also, our expenses have been below budget for the same time period. THANK YOU!
- We are still in need of members to help with the van ministry. A volunteer will pick up people starting around 8:45. Depending on how many need a ride, the church van can be used or personal vehicle. One person has answered the call. More who help with this ministry, the work can be reduced on 2 or 3 individuals.
- There has been a suggestion of a cross being placed somewhere outside to help identify the campus as a church. Some ideas were brainstormed but more research and prayer needs to be invested into this suggestion.
- If you order materials, supplies, food or such, and submit the purchase for reimbursement, be aware that the policy manual requires that invoices be turned in within 5 business days of the purchase.
- Pastor Claudia made the morning announcements while being the interim pastor. The Board decided that a rotation would be started again. A few individuals have stepped up to do them. If you would like to be part of the rotation, please let Leann know.
