Taku & Katie Longkumer Update

FAMILY NEWS

We have had a lot going on! Thank you all for your prayers, support and expressions of sympathy as we walked through the final days of life with Taku's youngest brother, Imkong, who passed into eternity the end of March. Your concern and care through the past three years of his battle with cancer have been a comfort and encouragement.

About that same time we received news from Katie's father, Jim Thomas, that her Mom, Barb, was

not doing well. We determined that we needed to see her and made plans to both accompany our son Lima and his wife Asen on their trip to meet family in July. Suddenly we learned that Meren was encountering a challenging situation that we felt required Katie's presence to assist with child-care and general support and encouragement. So immediately upon the conclusion of our ministry in a south Indian town of Narasaropeta over Easter, Katie made a trip to Illinois. Within an hour of her arrival in Springfield she began baby-sitting duty with wonderful 3 year old Liam! Katie was surprised and concerned seeing her mother's condition. While there her mother was hospitalized and diagnosed with pneumonia. But only while in the hospital it was discovered that her esophagus was nearly closed and she was aspirating as she attempted eating and drinking. This has been the cause of her dramatic weight loss and general ill health. Finally released after 9 days of hospitalization (6 with nothing by mouth) and a minor surgery, she returned home very weak and on oxygen. Now nearly two weeks later, she is daily improving, gaining strength and gradually resuming normal activities (though still on oxygen). We pray to see her in much more robust health in July! With all this going on, Katie extended her stay for an additional two weeks, returning now the end of May.

While Katie was occupied with all the family matters in the US Taku continued fulfilling our commitments in India. Due to the tragic events in Sri Lanka, the plans of our Area Director, Rev. Dr. Ben Chan were disrupted and he came to NEI and joined Taku in ministry with the Council of Baptist Churches in North East India (CBCNEI) and North East Christian University (NECU). The past two weeks Taku has been meeting with church and community leaders in Hyderabad working out details and planning for the India Baptist Summit October 3-6. This is a strategic event to bring together Baptists throughout the nation to share concerns and challenges of the Indian church and explore ways to coordinate and encourage one another in extending the love of Christ and good news of the Gospel with the multitudes of unreached in India and beyond.

Prayer Requests

Please Pray for all the work preparing for the India Summit, that the local churches would come together and actively co-operate and assist in the provision for all the details involved in a gathering of this magnitude.

Please Pray for Katie's family: for full recovery for Katie's mother and for all our children.

Please Pray for the believers and churches in India, as the political situation in particular regions and general position of the governing powers present ever-increasing concerns and potential threat to believers and the church.

Please Pray for God's continued grace, strength and wisdom as we travel and work with so many varied members of the body of Christ.


